In 1998, CFUW-Calgary undertook *My Very Own Book Project* to provide less fortunate children with books they can own. From 2001 - 2010, our club presented the Calgary Urban Project Society's (CUPS) One World Child Development Centre with over 800 books and other learning materials.

Since 2008, CFUW-Calgary has also donated \$500 to fund 25 children's individual book bags through the *Welcome to Kindergarten Program*.

CFUW/Calgary has a long-standing history of funding scholarships and bursaries at the University of Calgary and Mount Royal University. Each year the donations and proceeds from the Scholarship activities aid in supporting the scholarships.
